Pursuant to a supplemental Initial Decision of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board dated August 9, 1973, the Commission has issued an operating license to Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. for operation of the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 2. Amendment No. 3 to DPR-26 authorizes continued testing and steady state reactor core power operations at 1379 megawatts thermal (50 percent of full power) through September 30, 1973, in accordance with the provisions of the license and the Technical Specifications.
