Dear Dr. Walske:

Pursuant to the Orders of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board dated July 20, 1971, and October 15, 1971, respectively, the Atomic Energy Commission has issued Facility Operating License No. DPR-26 (three copies enclosed) to the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. The license permits fuel loading and subcritical testing of the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 2. The reactor is designed for operation at approximately 2758 megawatts thermal, but in accordance with the provisions of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26 and the Technical Specifications appended thereto, is restricted to fuel loading and subcritical testing and at no time shall the reactor be made critical following fuel loading. Three copies of a related notice which has been forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for filing and publication are enclosed for your information.
