Dear Mr. Bauser:

The Atomic Energy Commission has issued an Order extending the expiration date of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26 for the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc.'s Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 2 from April 19, 1972 to July 19, 1972.

This extension was necessary because of delays in completion of the facility that have occurred due to a fire in the primary auxiliary building. Further, licensing delays have occurred as a result of the contested nature of the public hearing which is in progress.

Two copies of a petition for order extending expiration date from the Consolidated Edison Company, together with two copies of the Order, are enclosed for the information of the Committee. The Order has been transmitted to the Office of the Federal Register for publication.
