
Confirming our telephone discussions of 20 July 1995, NMI remains on a path to provide to the NRC a D&D plan for the holding basin by NLT 15 August 1995.

As we also discussed NMI has been persistent in our efforts to secure confirming information from the Army supportive of our interpretation of government contracts as presented by NMI and our EME consultants to the NRC. A meeting with the Army is currently being arranged for the latter part of next week with the intended purpose of securing this written confirmation. We had indicated to you earlier that either contract modification or this written confirmation would be used in part to support an exemption request submission regarding the D&D rule under 10CFR40.36

As I further indicated to you, owing to the importance of this topic and as demonstrative of our sincere efforts to satisfy the intent of the regulations, our plans are to submit the exemption request along with the the D&D plan on 15 August 1995 even if this Army correspondence is delayed.

We feel that progress has been made in our discussions concerning the holding basin remediation with the Army and our overall efforts toward D&D funding requirements.

We would be happy to respond to any additional questions regarding the above.
