Mr. Bermudez,

In your request for information below please note the following.

Item #1 Below: **Yes**, please remove the J.L. Shepherd Cs-137 source from Dr. Artz's authorization in Condition Item 12B.

Item #2 Below: **Yes**, add tritium to Dr. Artz's authorization in Condition 12B.

Item #3 Below: **No, do not remove authorization of Items 6, 7 and 8F for 10 CFR 31.11 material.** We have no plans to and did not request the removal of these items. The items discussed for removal with Mr. McKinley and included in my amendment request dated 11/13/2009 were as follows.

Please remove **Item E (6, 7 and 8E)** in which the device and the sources were not acquired.

Please remove **Item H (6, 7 and 8 H)** in which the Gd-153 sources were transferred as noted in the amendment request which included documentations supporting this.

Hello Dr. Lowe,

As part of my review of your license amendment request I noticed that although CAMC is authorized to possess 31.11 materials and tritium (items 6.F and 6.J of your license, amendment 56) there is no one listed as an authorized user for those materials. Your license also lists Dr. Artz as responsible for the J.L. Shepherd cesium source that was removed from your license during the previous amendment. I also noted that the most recent inspection report indicates you plan to request removal of 31.11 authorization.

Should I:

1. Delete the Shepherd source from Dr. Artz's authorization (Condition 12.B)?
2. Add tritium to Dr. Artz's authorization?
3. Remove 31.11 authorization?

If you want to remove the 31.11 materials I need to know their disposition. I am aware that you are requesting removal of the gadolinium sources, so I will remove them from Dr. Artz/s authorization also. (Condition 12.B).
