In accordance with the requirements for Implementation of the Convention of the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material, AREVA NP Inc. is submitting the information below regarding our upcoming export shipment to Germany under export license XSNM3505-R. 2. Physical Description

Thirty Six (36) ANF-250 shipping containers which contain 2,368 Kgu and 65 KgU²³⁵, at an average enrichment of 2.74 wt% U²³⁵. The ANF-250's are loaded into one sea container.

3. Transport Route

The shipment will depart Richland, WA for Baltimore, MD by truck, where it will be loaded onto ACL's vessel, Atlantic Cartier at the Port of Baltimore. The shipment will depart Baltimore, MD going to Hamburg, Germany. Upon arrival at Hamburg, Advance Nuclear Fuels, GmbH or its agent will take custody of the shipment and transport it to its facility at Lingen, Germany.

4. Schedule

The shipment is scheduled to depart Richland on September 21, 2009 and depart Baltimore, MD on September 24, 2009. It is scheduled to arrive at Hamburg, Germany on October 10, 2009 and arrive at Lingen, Germany on October 12, 2009.

5. Assurance

The shipment will be protected during transport in accordance with IAEA Information Circular 225, "Physical Protection of Nuclear Materials".
