Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc., (Entergy) is in receipt of NRC Orders EA-09-204 and EA-09-205 transmitted by NRC letter dated November 23, 2009. Entergy respectfully requests an extension until January 22 to respond to these orders. Entergy currently has controls in place which will meet the intent of the intent of the orders to provide enhanced controls. Unit 1 has several radioactive items of concern as identified in Table 1 of Attachment B to Enclosure 1 of the NRC letter. These items are within the protected area of the Indian Point site and additional controls are in place within the protected area to restrict access.
