Enclosed is an application (XSNM3626) recently received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), dated December 30, 2009, from Mitsui & Co. (U.S.A.), Inc., for the export of low-enriched uranium to Japan for use as reload fuel in Units 3 and 4 of the Fukushima II nuclear power reactor; and Units 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Kashiwazaki-Kariwa nuclear power reactors.

Assurances from Japan that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of an agreement for cooperation are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.

Please note that the material is of Canadian origin, converted in Canada; and enriched and re-converted in the U.S. It, thus, has Canadian obligations.
