



Dear Mr. Seeborg:

Notice was recently given by the Atomic Energy Commission that there will be a Public Hearing on August 31 at Buchanan, New York, in reference to the proposed construction of a large nuclear power at Indian Point by Consolidated Edison.

Little publicity was given this notice and we find many interested public organizations are unaware of the hearings. The season of the year makes it difficult for interested parties to do research in sufficient time to have informed representatives at the hearing.

Because this is such a major step and there appear to be compelling reasons for questioning the safety of such a plant so close to populous areas unless special precautions are taken, we request this hearing be postponed and sufficient time be allowed in setting the date for another hearing to allow parties who desire to be heard a chance to prepare.
