
Dear Dr. Seaborg:

It has come to my attention that your Commission is giving serious consideration to the operation of Nuclear Plant #2 on the Indian Point which is located along the Hudson River.

I have received complaints from residents from my congressional district part of which is located along the Hudson River area. Many of them feel were this Plant permitted to operate in this vicinity it would have adverse affect upon the fishing sport which is quite prevalent in this area and would also create a real pollution problem due to the dead fish which might wash into the shoreline as a result of the cleaning chlorides.
