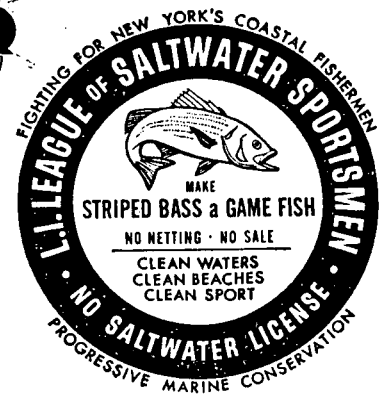

Dear Mr. Jensch:

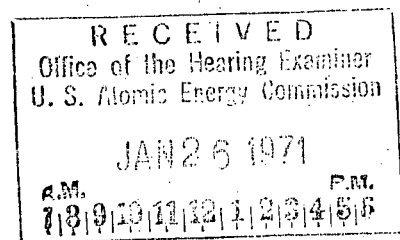
