Gentlemen:

As Chairman of the Action for Clean Air Council of the Lower Hudson Valley, it has come to the attention of the undersigned that you are conducting public hearings with regard to the second atomic power plant at Indian Point, Westchester County, New York. Our Council covers the Lower Hudson Valley and particularly the area along the Hudson River which will be affected by this installation.

We trust that in reviewing this application and all the pertinent data with respect to possible air pollution effects, you will see that the application is strictly reviewed and that if the same is granted, every possible precaution is taken to see that this facility is so designed and constructed as well as operated to prevent damaging air pollution.

Members of our Council have also asked where we can obtain records of the test results in connection with the present and future operations at Indian Point. This would presumably include testing results of the immediate operation as well as the results of the monitoring stations in the area.

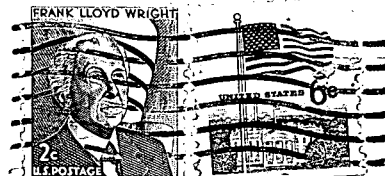
