MOTION OF APPLICANT FOR AN ORDER TO PERMIT
FUEL LOADING AND SUB-CRITICAL TESTING

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc.

(Applicant) respectfully moves that in accordance with the Notice of Hearing in this proceeding, dated November 13, 1970, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board issue an order pursuant to Section 2.730(e) of the Atomic Energy Commission's Rules of Practice (10 CFR §2.730(e)) authorizing the Director of Regulation (a) to make appropriate findings on the matters specified in said Notice of Hearing and (b) to issue a license to Applicant authorizing it to commence and complete the initial fuel loading of the reactor vessel in Indian Point Unit No. 2 and to conduct sub-critical testing of the facility.

A description of such activities and the extent to which the

facility will be completed prior to their commencement is found in the affidavit of Applicant's Vice-President, William J. Cahill, Jr., which accompanies and is attached to this motion.

In support of this motion Applicant cites the evidence heretofore introduced by it and by the AEC Regulatory Staff in this proceeding and the above-mentioned affidavit.
