



Dear Mr. Roisman:

This is in response to your "Request to the Staff for Production of Documents by the Citizens Committee for Protection of the Environment," dated May 24, 1971.

The following will identify your specific requests for documents and our response:

1. "All recent tests and analysis of tests conducted with respect to the emergency core cooling system and referred to in the April 27, 1971 letter from Chairman Seaborg to the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy."

Enclosed are six monthly reports prepared by the Idaho Nuclear Corporation during the period from November 1970 through April 1971 relating to certain emergency core cooling system tests performed for the AEC. The first five of these reports deal with the tests referred to in the Chairman's letter.

2. "A list of all documents and other data considered by the senior task force which is reevaluating the emergency core cooling system, the list to be updated as required and a detailed description of that review."

3. "The analysis and conclusions of the senior task force with respect to its review of the emergency core cooling system."

Until the work of the task force is completed, we believe it to be premature to consider providing this requested information. At the time the work of the task force is completed, we will be in a position to consider such a request in accordance with the provisions

of 10 CFR Section 2.744 of the Commission's "Rules of Practice." The scope of the task force's review is identified in the Chairman's letter.

4. "An Evaluation of Anticipated Operational Transients in Westinghouse Pressurized Water Reactors dated March 5, 1971."

Counsel for the applicant has indicated to us that the applicant will furnish you with a copy of this report.

5. "All data relied upon by the Staff and Consumers Power Company in adopting and approving the sodium thiosulfate for the iodine removal system for the Midlands Nuclear Plant."

Enclosed herewith are copies of excerpts of those portions of Oak Ridge National Laboratory Reports ORNL-TM-2412 and ORNL 4360 which were relied on by the staff in its review of the Midland iodine removal system. Complete reports can be obtained from Oak Ridge National Laboratory.

In addition, the staff considered - Babcock & Wilcox Topical Report BAW 10024 - "Effectiveness of Sodium Thiosulfate Sprays for Iodine Removal." Because we do not have any extra copies of this report to furnish to you, we will make one copy available in the Commission's Public Document Room at 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C. for your inspection or copying. We will also endeavor to have the applicant or Babcock & Wilcox send a copy of this report to you.

We also reviewed Babcock & Wilcox Topical Reports BAW 10017 and BAW 10022 which are proprietary reports of the company. We will undertake to determine from the company whether these reports can be made available for your inspection in accordance with the procedure you propose in your "Request."
