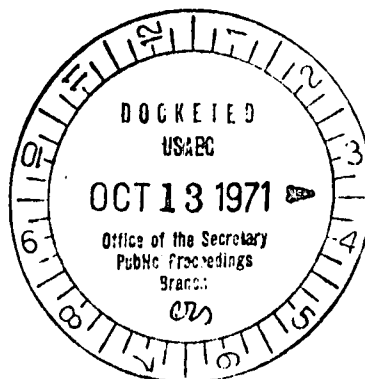
Dear Mr. Roisman:

I have a copy of your letter of October 8, 1971 to Mr. Martin concerning the understandings reached among Con Edison, HRFA and EDF.
