

Gentlemen:

At the evidentiary hearing session in subject proceeding held on October 5, 1971, the presiding Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board), upon the agreement of the parties, ruled that it would accept as evidence a statement to be subsequently submitted by the regulatory staff relating to the environmental considerations of activities which would be authorized if applicant's motion for fuel loading and subcritical testing was granted. (Transcript page 1539) The Board also ruled that the statement was accepted upon the basis that if a staff witness were present and sworn, he would testify as the statement will reflect.


