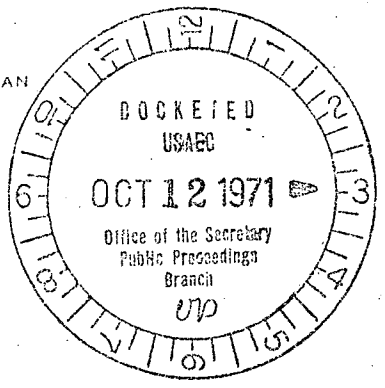

Dear Bruce:

As you requested, enclosed is the schedule for environmental matters as agreed to by Con Ed, EDF and HREA and as approved by the Board at the hearings on October 5.

1. Consideration of Applicants Request for a 50% testing license -- at the conclusion of the radiological safety hearing commencing on November 1. Applicant to introduce supporting evidence.
2. Applicants proposed findings on 50% testing 7 days after hearing, all other parties 7 days after receipt of Applicants proposed findings, Applicants reply 4 days later.
3. Applicants proposed findings on radiological safety 20 days after end of November hearings. All other parties on or before January 11. Applicants reply within 10 days.
4. Detailed statement of position on environmental matters by EDF and HREA - December 1, 1971.

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5. Hearings on environmental matters;

- a. December 14-17
- b. January 11-21

6. Staff Environmental Statement - Prior to hearings in December if possible and certainly before conclusion of hearings in January.

7. Applicants proposed findings on all environmental matters 14 days after end of hearings. All other parties 14 days later. Applicants reply 10 days later.
