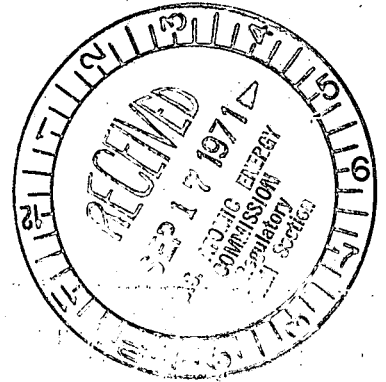
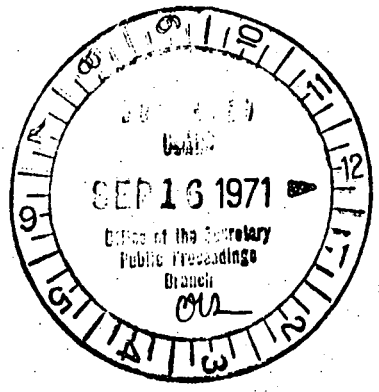

months and was sent the list of documents considered by the Staff fully two weeks before his September 9 letter. He requested no documents from either the Staff or the Applicant from July 21 until September 9.

We do not know what Mr. Roisman means by his statement that he has not received from the Staff the tests and analyses of those tests which necessitated the Task Force Review. As far as Applicant is concerned, Mr. Roisman has no outstanding requests for documents except that contained in his September 9 letter. Although we will review Mr. Roisman's last minute request for additional documents with a view to supplying him with appropriate material, he cannot justify a delay in this hearing by his own failure to act promptly. is no basis for Mr. Roisman to cite the fact that environmental hearings are required under the revised 10 CFR 50 Appendix D as a reason for delay. Section D.1 specifically states that "the presiding Atomic Safety and Licensing Board will, if the requirements of paragraphs 1-9 of Section A have not as yet been met, proceed expeditiously" with the radiological hearing. Applicant reiterates the request contained in my telegram of September 9, 1971.
