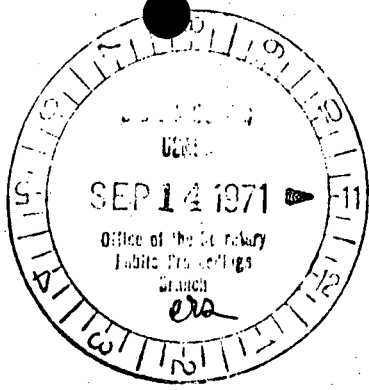

On September 3, 1971, the Regulatory Staff submitted to the Board and the parties the Staff's supplemental safety evaluation relative to the emergency core cooling system for Unit 2. Earlier submissions relative to the emergency core cooling system were made by the Staff on July 22, August 13, and August 25, 1971. In view of the latest submission by the Staff, Applicant believes it is now appropriate to establish the date for the hearing to reconvene.
