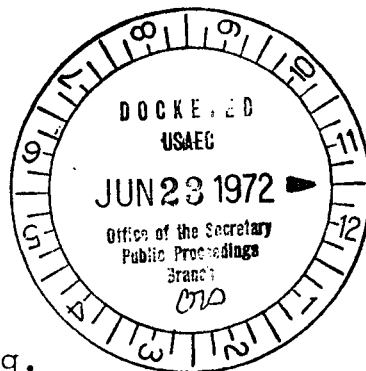


Gentlemen:
