Reference is made to your letter, dated April 21, 1972, to the Secretary of the Commission relating to limited appearance statements.

Participation by a person not a party to a proceeding is regulated by 10CFR Section 2.715(a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Commission (copy attached). The Indian Point Unit No. 2 hearing has been in progress since December 1970, and the time for submitting limited appearance statements normally is at the commencement of the hearing. You may however, request that the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board presiding in the Indian Point hearing permit a limited appearance statement to be submitted at this late date. There are no required forms for such request, although it is suggested you advise the Board of the statement you may wish to submit. The Chairman of the Board is Mr. Samuel W. Jensch, U.S. Atomic Energy Commission, Washington, D.C. 20545.
