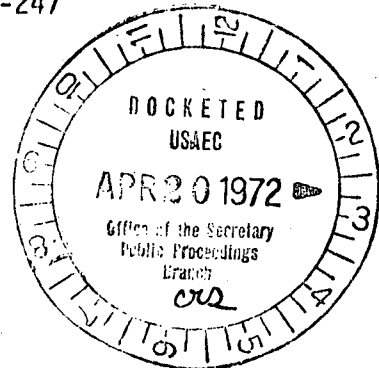

RESPONSE OF AEC REGULATORY STAFF TO MOTION
OF CITIZENS COMMITTEE FOR PROTECTION OF THE
ENVIRONMENT TO REQUIRE APPLICANT AND STAFF
TO SUBMIT EVIDENCE



On April 10, 1972, the Citizens Committee for the Protection of the Environment (Citizens Committee) filed a motion to require the applicant and the staff to introduce into evidence at the next hearing session data, including oral testimony, relevant to six enumerated radiological safety items.

The regulatory staff intends to furnish the Board and the parties, prior to the next hearing session, its proposed evidence relevant to the enumerated items.

The regulatory staff takes exception to the gratuitous, unsupported, and unwarranted observation on page 5 of the motion, with respect to the staff's attitude.
