Dear Mr. Roisman:

Reference is made to your letter, dated April 6, 1972, requesting the staff to inquire as to the availability of Drs. Mishima, Rittenhouse and Hobson to attend the next session of hearings to discuss the subject of organic iodine release fractions.

Pursuant to our telephone conversation of April 18, it is my understanding that you desire the regulatory staff to bring the above mentioned gentlemen to the hearing, as staff witnesses at government expense, so that you may cross-examine them concerning articles they wrote (ORNL 4635 and BNWL 319) which are subjects of an official notice motion pending before the Board.

As you are well aware, all the testimony of the applicant and staff on the iodine removal subject in the Indian Point No. 2 hearing is now in evidence. You completed your cross-examination of the witnesses who appeared, and proposed findings and responses thereto are now before the Board.

The regulatory staff has no intention of having Drs. Mishima, Rittenhouse and Hobson testify as their witnesses at the hearing. We have presented our evidence on the requested subject, and the regulatory staff witness who testified was well aware of the views of Messrs. Mishima, Rittenhouse and Hobson.
