The Life History Of Uranium:

URANIUM is mined in Colorado; Utah; Wyoming; S. Dakota; Arizona; N. Mexico; Texas; Washington; Oregon: And it goes through many stages and names. As URANIUM decays naturally, it changes into THORIUM, which then decays and turns into RADIUM. AS RADIUM decays it turns into a gas called RADON that seeps through concrete, and quickly decays into POLONIUM and radioactive forms of LEAD and BISMUTH.

These last three radioactive elements called RADON DAUGHTERS, have been recognized for over 40 years, as the cause of high rates of lung cancer among URANIUM and RADIUM miners.

This same radiation from RADON DAUGHTERS that affected the miners is now found in and around homes in Colorado because of the use of "mill tailings". Processing at mills removes only 15% of the radioactivity from the ores that are brought in. The other 85% goes into the dump pile. Because of the extraordinary long life of RADIUM and THORIUM, these piles represent a long term health problem. Is it any wonder why one must look at URANIUM with fear?


