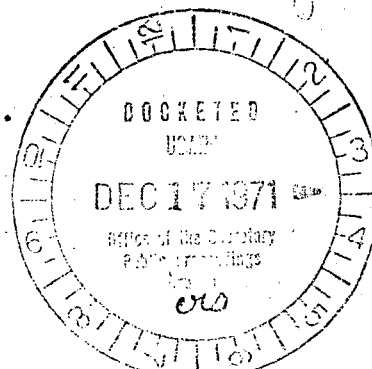
That petition is hereby made to intervene generally in this proceeding on the grounds that all the petitioners live within twenty-five miles of Indian Point Plant #2 and well within the radius of damage considered likely as set forth in the AEC document known as Wash - 740.

That petitioners appeared as intervenors on December 1, 1970 and as limited intervenors on December 17, 1970 and on several occasions during October 1971 and submitted statements in writing on several of these occasions. From the applicant no answer has ever been received as to the contentions of intervenors with respect to the safety of this plant, the loss-of-coolant problem, the waste disposal and storage systems, radiation and thermal pollution, environmental effects of the plant, etc. Petitioners therefore wish to restate their position, secure answers of the applicant, and adduce new evidence of the environmental effect of this plant, and examine and cross-examine witnesses.

Wherefore petitioners ask leave to intervene generally as is permitted by 10 CFR Sec. 2.714 and the Notice of Hearing dated 29th November 1971.
