On January 11, 2010, a conference call between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and General Electric-Hitachi (GEH) staffs was held to discuss proposed responses to the Requests for Additional Information (RAIs) applicable to GEH's Standard Practice Procedures Plan for the Protection of Classified Matter for the Facility Clearance Application for GEH's laser-based uranium enrichment facility. The RAIs applicable to this conference call had been transmitted to GEH on December 4, 2009.

#### DISCUSSION:

GEH staff discussed proposed responses to RAIs addressing terminology, contractors, the classified mailing address, physical checks, use of standard forms, use of detection systems, and Communications Security accounts. GEH staff stated that the locations where detection systems would be used have not yet been determined, but the information would be provided when the requested information becomes available.

NRC staff indicated that it appears the proposed responses will provide the information needed.
