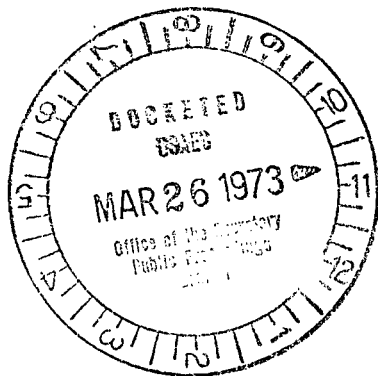
Dear Leonard and Myron,
