



Dear Mr. Newman:

Your letter of January 18, 1973 requested that we withhold from public disclosure a proprietary report entitled "Fuel Densification - Indian Point Nuclear Generating Station, Unit No. 2" dated January, 1973.

The staff upon examination of the proprietary fuel densification report has reached the conclusion that in accordance with Section 2.790(b), this document has been found to contain information which both reveals the distinguishing aspects of the process of whose exclusive use by Westinghouse constitutes a competitive economic advantage over other companies, and whose use by a competitor would reduce his expenditure for resources in the design, manufacture, assurance of quality or licensing of a similar product.

Based on the foregoing, we have approved your request, and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790, the proprietary fuel densification report will be withheld from public disclosure.
