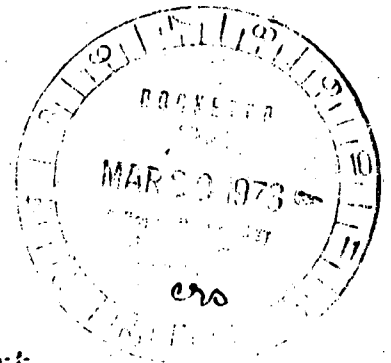

Pursuant to Title 10 Code of Federal Regulations Part 20.407, a report of the exposure to individuals at the Indian Point Station of the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., in the calendar year of 1972, is submitted. This facility is operated pursuant to Provisional Operating License No. DPR-5 and DPR-26.

The total number of individuals for whom personal monitoring was provided per, 20.407 (b) (1) (ii), during the calendar year of 1972 was 1256.

The total number of visitors for whom personal monitoring was provided during the calendar year of 1972 was 120.

Attached hereto as Table No. 1 is the name, Social Security number, date of birth and exposure of each individual over 18 years of age whose radiation dose for the calendar year of 1972 exceeded 1250 millirems.

Attached hereto as Table No. 2 is a summary of recorded Annual Wholebody Exposures between 0 and 1.25 Rem for calendar year 1972.

During this year, there were no individuals under 18 years of age exposed to radiation at this facility.

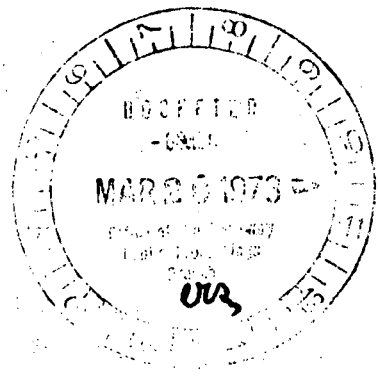

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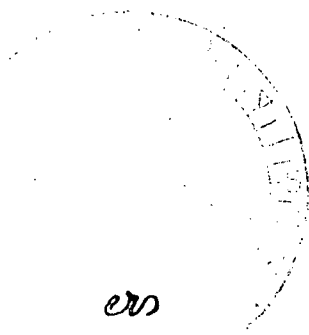
