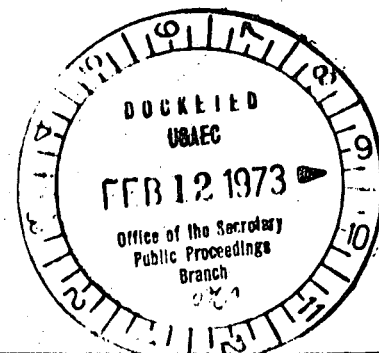

6. Document describing the scope and duration of the Hudson River-Indian Point ecological studies to be conducted by New York University Laboratory for Environmental Studies.


