

APPLICATION TO WITHHOLD MATERIAL FROM
THE PUBLIC RECORD


Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc.
("Consolidated Edison"), Applicant in the above-captioned proceeding, pursuant to Sections 2.790(b) and 9.5(4)(i) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, requests that the document transmitted to the Commission by letter dated January 18, 1973 and entitled, "Fuel Densification--Indian Point Nuclear Generating Station Unit No. 2", dated January 1973 be withheld in part from public disclosure. In support of such request, Consolidated Edison states as follows:

(1) Consolidated Edison understands that certain parts of the aforesaid document constitute trade secrets, inventions and discoveries and/or proprietary data of Westinghouse Electric Corporation within the meaning of Section 9.5(4)(i) of the Commission's Regulations and are, therefore, exempted from public disclosure.

(2) Consolidated Edison has transmitted by letter dated January 18, 1973 copies of a non-proprietary version of the aforesaid document for which exemption from disclosure is not requested.

WHEREFORE, Consolidated Edison requests that the information contained in the aforesaid proprietary document be withheld from public disclosure to the extent that such information is not contained in the submittal made under Paragraph 2 above pursuant to Sections 2.790(b) and 9.5(4)(i) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
