

SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF FOLLOW-UP CLOSED MEETING HELD ON
DECEMBER 15, 2009, TO DISCUSS THE SOUTH TEXAS PROJECT UNITS 3
AND 4 EMERGENCY CORE COOLING SUCTION STRAINERS

On December 15, 2009, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a closed meeting in Rockville, Maryland, with members of the South Texas Project Nuclear Operating Company (STPNOC). The purpose of this follow-up meeting was to discuss the outstanding technical issues with STPNOC regarding the Combined License Application and Requests for Additional Information (RAI) Questions 06.02.02-14 and 04.04-3 for the Emergency Core Cooling System Suction Strainers.

The staff had previously provided the applicant with a draft list of RAIs (RAIs 4115, 4116 and 4133). These RAIs, which can be found in the Agencywide Document Access and Management System (ADAMS) under ML093480253, ML093480228 and ML093510961) were discussed in detail during the December 2, 2009 meeting to ensure that the applicant understood the requests being made by the staff. During the December 15th meeting, the staff held further discussions on Question Numbers 06.02.02-14 and 04.04-3. The applicant committed to respond to these questions by January 15, 2010.
