This letter confirms the discussion between Myron Karman of this office and James Tourtellotte concerning the need for a witness from the Federal Power Commission on power needs for the operating license proceeding concerning the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Plant Unit No. 2 (Docket 50-247). The hearing concerning the need for power and other environmental issues will commence on December 4, 1972, at Croton-On-Hudson, New York. At this time, it is not certain that the need for power will be a matter in controversy at the hearing, but it is our desire to have a witness from your office available in the event his presence at the hearing is required.
