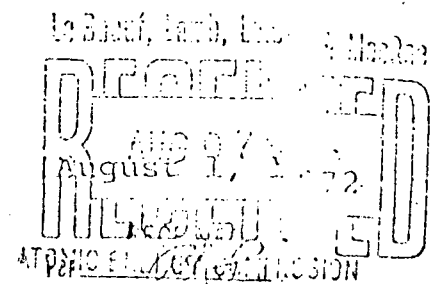

Dear Mr. Muller

In the course of the comments by federal and state agencies on the Draft Detailed Statement for Indian Point Unit No. 1, the question arose of the relationship of the Hudson River Policy Committee to the research program described by Con Edison. This matter has been reviewed with the Hudson River Policy Committee and we have clarified relationships.

Because of problems of contract management and administration and manpower limitations, the Hudson River Policy Committee will, with respect to the Indian Point studies, assume the role of a Study Steering Committee. The Steering Committee will review the scope of the work and its execution and, where necessary or desirable, submit recommendations for changes to Con Edison. Con Edison, as contract administrator, will order the changes to be made. The Steering Committee would also review, comment upon and make recommendations concerning periodic progress reports and preliminary and final findings and recommendations. The Committee will maintain, at no expense to it, a full-time representative on-site whose authority to act for the Committee will be determined by the Committee.
