Gentlemen,

For nearly 400 years the County of Westchester in New York State has been operating a dump on the Hudson River, at Croton Point, about 25 miles north of New York City.

It was disclosed several years ago that some radioactive waste had been dumped there. I had the impression at that time that this had occurred only a few times. However, I recently read a news story which indicated that this was a continuing practice.

If this is the case, then I feel that the Federal government ought to take whatever action is possible to 1) Assure that this will not happen in the future, 2) That it will be discontinued immediately, and 3) That present remains be removed at the earliest possible date.
