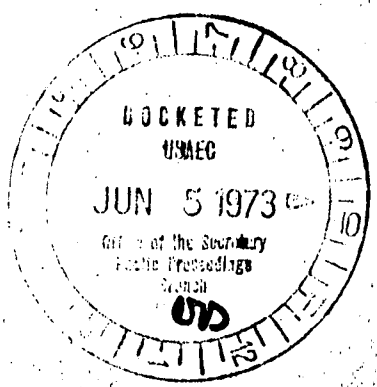

On May 25, 1973 the plant was again taken critical, and several zero power physics tests, including rod worth measurements and moderator temperature coefficient measurements, were performed. Minimum shutdown verification was performed on May 30. The plant was again brought to criticality early this morning, and zero power physics testing has been resumed.
