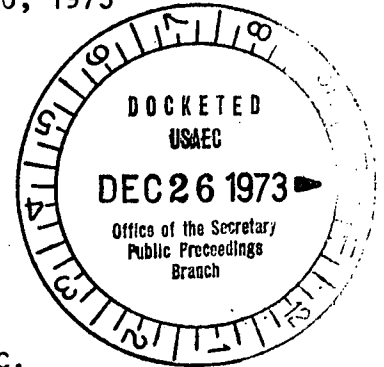

Exhibit No. 2: which was a detailed statement including applicant's environmental report as Appendix A, was received in evidence at Tr., p. 409.


Exhibit No. 3: which was staff's print-out of project numbers associated with water reactors' safety program, was received in evidence at Tr., p. 1085.
