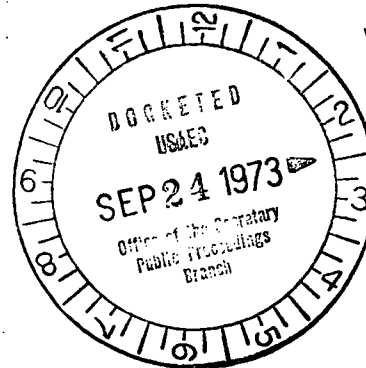

We received today a copy of your letter to the Board of September 19, 1973.

Under the circumstances there is no basis for your request that the Board postpone any decision with respect to Indian Point No. 2.
