Gentlemen:

Forwarded herewith are the staff's proposed revisions to the Radiological Technical Specifications in the subject proceeding. These revisions have been labeled Change No. 2 to the Technical Specifications issued on April 20, 1973, as Appendix A with Amendment No. 1 to the Facility Operating License DPR-26. The staff intends that Change No. 2 be issued with any additional licensing action authorized by the Board. Change No. 1 was issued on May 16, 1973, and previously sent to the Board.

The revisions included in Change No. 2 can be identified by the label Change No. 2 printed in the lower right-hand corner of each page. The principal purpose of the revisions is to update the Technical Specifications to reflect current Regulatory staff requirements.

Section 3.9 "Effluent Release," has been revised in its entirety to include specific numerical requirements in order to maintain radioactivity release to as low as practicable. Requirements for equipment utilization and reporting have also been expanded. Specification 4.11 "Radioactive Materials," has been added to define an adequate program of periodic tests and record requirements. Both of the above specification changes are consistent with the current Regulatory staff enforcement of the as low as practicable requirements of 10 CFR Part 50.

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Section 6 "Administrative Controls," has been revised in its entirety to reflect the standard format used by the Regulatory staff in current Technical Specifications. This standard format is more complete and includes assurances that the applicable provisions of Regulatory Guides 1.16 "Reporting of Operating Information," 1.21 "Measuring and Reporting of Effluents from Nuclear Power Plants," and 1.33 "Quality Assurance Program Requirements (Operation)," are adequately addressed.

Other revisions made are in the nature of minor word changes or clarifications.
