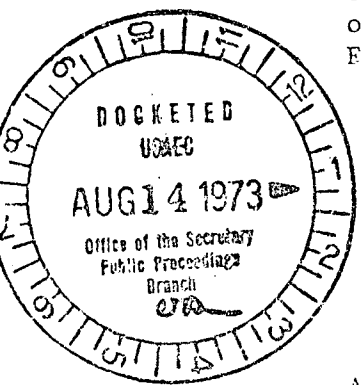

I have received the August 2, 1973 letter of Con Edison's counsel to the Board enclosing the two orders of the Federal Power Commission on the Cornwall or Storm King Project.
