Gentlemen:

Reference is made to Mr. Roisman's letter of April 3, 1974, received by the undersigned on April 9, 1974, and Mr. Trosten's response thereto of April 4, 1974, relative to applicant's security program. This is to advise the Appeal Board that Mr. Trosten's account of my actions to recover or eliminate the copies of Mr. Skovholt's letter of March 29, 1974 inadvertently disseminated by the staff, is accurate.

With respect to Mr. Roisman's request to the Appeal Board to shut down the plant, the staff believes that the arming of guards in accordance with Regulatory Guide 1.17 will provide additional security to the plant, over and above that found to be adequate by the Licensing Board. However, the fact that the guards will not be armed prior to June 15, 1974 does not jeopardize the security of the station. The station has an adequate guard force which has available to it direct communication facilities for an immediate response by armed law enforcement officials, which for Indian Point are located within two miles of the facility.
