In checking our files I do not find copies of correspondence sent by you to Consolidated Edison (Indian Point #2) and referred to in Mr. Cahill's March 25, 1974 letter to you. The reference item is Directorate of Regulatory Operations Information Request No. 74-2. We also have not received No. 74-1 nor any inspection reports or other compliance communications.

Pursuant to the position taken by the Director of Regulation, as a party to the Indian Point #2 proceeding, Citizens Committee for Protection of the Environment is entitled to all communications from the AEC to the Applicant.
