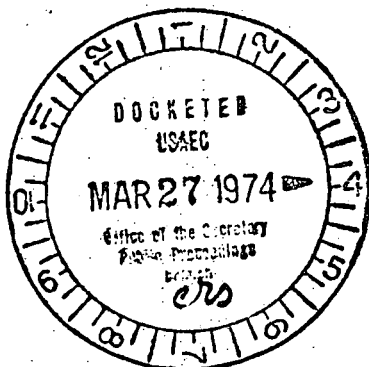
Gentlemen:

With reference to the letter of the Attorney General of the State of New York dated March 21, 1974 the Proposed Effluent Limitations Guidelines and Standards issued by the Environmental Protection Agency are merely proposed and are not in effect. (39 Fed. Reg. 8294). No requirement now exists for the termination of Applicant's once-through cooling system by July 1, 1978 or, as the Attorney General earlier stated to this Board, by July 1, 1977.
