

In accordance with your letter of November 30, 1973, concerning amendments to regulations in 10 CFR, Parts 50, 70, and 73, we have completed the requested review.

As a result of this review, we have concluded that our present security plan complies with all applicable requirements of 10 CFR, Part 73.


The security plan entitled, "Indian Point Station Security Plan" was submitted following Tr. 6 in the in-camera session of the Indian Point Unit No. 2 Hearing on November 12, 1971 and approved in the "Supplemental Staff Testimony" following Tr. 6 of the in-camera session of the Hearings on December 14, 1971.

For your convenience, three copies of the subject plan and the supplemental staff testimony are enclosed with this letter. Pursuant to Section 2.790(d) of 10 CFR, Part 2, documents and correspondence relating to facility security provisions are normally withheld from public disclosure. We, therefore, request that the enclosed security plan, "Indian Point Station Security Plan", dated September 18, 1971 and the "Supplemental Staff Testimony" be withheld from public disclosure, and receive limited distribution in accordance with Commission regulations.
