On July 31, 1974, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board (Board) issued an order requiring, among other things, that the Staff file and serve, on or before August 16, 1974, affidavits with respect to: (1) evidence of site inspections to verify full implementation of the Security Plan at Indian Point Station, Unit #2; (2) identification of areas outside the plant considered by the Staff for security purposes; and (3) a statement concerning the freezer-dryer issue which has been raised in this case.

The affidavits on security were prepared by AEC Staff in King of Prussia, Pennsylvania, and deposited in the U.S. mails on or about August 12, 1974, but have not yet been received by Staff Counsel. In addition, principle Staff Counsel is on vacation and will not return until August 26, 1974. The AEC Staff are of the belief that appropriate action can be taken and the Board's Order can be fully complied with if Staff is granted additional time to consolidate, review, and finalize the submittals required by the Board's Order.

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Staff respectfully requests an extension until August 23, 1974, in which to comply with the Board's Order. Counsel for both Applicant and Intervenor were contacted and voiced no objection.
