APPLICANT'S MOTION FOR A
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On February 6, 1976, a Notice of Hearing was issued in the above-captioned matter. 41 Fed. Reg. 5459 (1976). Since that time the Regulatory Staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission has prepared and published a Draft Environmental Statement (NUREG 0080). 41 Fed. Reg. 29228 (1976). In view of the extraordinary amount of time that has elapsed since the filing on June 6, 1975 of the application for an extension of the period of once-through cooling interim operation for Indian Point Station, Unit No. 2, and the fact that issue is now being joined by the parties, and considering the status of related proceedings and litigation concerning the cooling system for this facility, it is timely that a prehearing conference be convened to focus the issues in this proceeding and to take other appropriate actions.

Accordingly, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. moves, pursuant to Sections 2.730 and 2.752 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.730, 2.752 (1976), for an order convening a prehearing conference as

soon as possible.

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
