HRFA MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME


The Hudson River Fishermen's Association ("HRFA") respectfully requests an extension of time for the filing of briefs in the above-captioned proceeding from the currently designated September 28, 1977^{*/} until October 14, 1977.

There are two reasons which necessitate this request. The first is that counsel for HRFA will be out of the office for the last three weeks of September on a vacation which was planned prior to the issuance of the Commission's Order. The second reason is that the law offices of HRFA's counsel are being moved on October 1 to 122 East 42nd Street, 45th Floor, New York, New York 10017. Both of these facts make it extremely difficult for HRFA to submit a brief, as it would like to do, within the time frame set by the Order.

^{*/} In its Order of August 26, 1977, the Commission invited submission of briefs on the issues within 30 days of service of the Order. The Order was served by mail on August 26. Section 2.710 of the Commission rules provides for the addition of 3 days to the prescribed period when service is by mail. Thus we calculate that September 28, 1977 is the last day for submission of briefs under the Commission's Order.

All parties to the proceeding before the Commission have been contacted. None opposes the proposed extension on condition that all parties are granted the same extension until October 14, 1977.
