— SARAH CHASIS, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am the attorney for the Hudson River Fishermen's Association in this proceeding. I make this affidavit in support of the foregoing Motion Requesting a Finding that All Governmental Approvals Required Under the License Have Been Received and for the Establishment of an Appropriate Termination Date for Once-Through Cooling.

2. On August 29, 1977, I spoke with Mr. Carl D'Alvia, Attorney for the Village of Buchanan, in order to determine what actions, if any, the Village of Buchanan Zoning Board of Appeals ("the Zoning Board") had taken with respect to the granting of variances for construction of the cooling tower at Indian Point 2. Mr. D'Alvia informed me that no variances embodying local and incidental regulation had

been granted by the Zoning Board for construction of the cooling tower. In fact, Mr. D'Alvia stated that no action of any kind directed toward the issuance of such variances had been taken.
