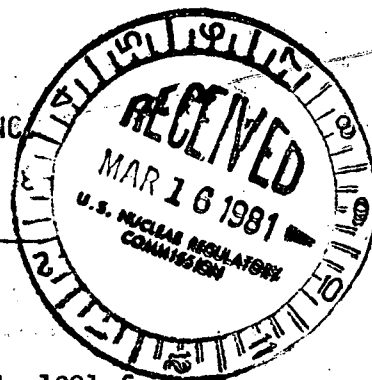

The Staff recently received a copy of a letter dated March 4, 1981 from Melvin L. Goldberg of the New York Public Interest Research Group (NYPIRG) to Chairman Miller.
