It is ridiculous to think that these plants could be operating when there is no sure way to dispose of the waste and the radio active elements used have half lives of hundreds of thousands of years.

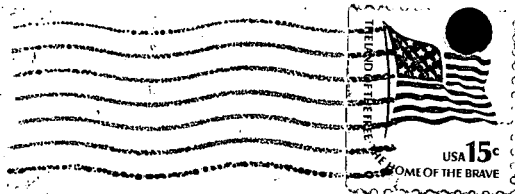
Please listen to those of us who are pleading with you to realize that we cannot keep utilizing substances which cannot be returned to the life chain and not have them destroy us.
